### To the Armstrong Air and Space Museum

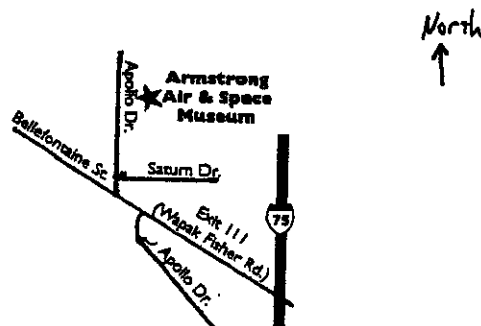
The Armstrong Museum is located just west of I-75 at exit 111 (Bellefontaine Street) in Wapakoneta, Auglaize County.

The map below shows how to get to the museum once you exit the interstate.

From Lima, Findley, and other points north, get to I-75 and travel south to exit 111.

From points southeast, take State Route 33 to I-75 and proceed north to the next ext, 111.

From the east, take your preferred route to I-75 and proceed to exit 111.
